### **Nike Centre for Performance – Head Coach Men**

Basketball Alberta is a not-for-profit provincial organization located at the Percy Page Centre in Edmonton, Alberta, and is responsible for the development and promotion of amateur Basketball in Alberta.

The NIKE Centre for Performance program is an elite program for players and coaches designed to teach individual offensive and team fundamentals while also presenting aspects of sports science that are necessary to become a high level and coach.

Basketball Alberta partners with Canada Basketball to present the CP program which brings together the top athletes and coaches from around the province. This program is for the top 12 - 18 year old male and female basketball athletes in Alberta. CP's operate between the months of September 6<sup>th</sup> through November 23<sup>rd</sup> each year. 60 hours of training and development are received by each athlete who participates.

The program seeks to:

- Offer developmental pathways for athletes and coaches who wish to be involved at the post secondary, provincial, national team or international levels.

The services to be provided by the Head Coaches include:

- Athlete identification;
- Curriculum delivery;
- On-court instruction of athletes at all team training sessions;
- Ongoing monitoring of athletes' physical training and skills;
- Communication and meetings with CP Assistant Coaches;
- Final evaluation of CP program and Assistant Coaches.

Coaches interested in the Head Coach Position should have the following qualifications:

- Complete NCCP Level 3 Certification in Basketball;
- Attend all scheduled team training coaches;
- Ability to lead and work cooperatively with other coaches;
- Ability to deliver the CP curriculum to athletes and coaches in an effective manner;
- Ability to promote the CP program and act in a professional manner as a representative of Basketball Alberta and Canada Basketball.

This is a one (1) year contract position. The salary portion of this position will be discussed and determined based upon the successful applicants experience and qualifications.
